

## PARA PROFESSIONAL

The board may employ para professionals or other instructional support personnel to assist certificated personnel in non-teaching duties, including, but not limited to:

- managing and maintaining records, materials and equipment;
- attending to the physical needs of children; and
- performing other limited services to support teaching duties when such duties are determined and directed by the teacher.

All para professionals must meet No Child Left Behind criteria for employment.

It shall be the responsibility of the building principal to supervise para professionals.
