

DRUG-FREE ENVIRONMENT

Smoking and the use of all tobacco products shall be prohibited in all indoor facilities and school vehicles owned and operated by the Wakefield Community School.

The use of alcoholic beverages in any form on school premises is strictly forbidden. Any group renting the school facilities must abide by this policy.

The Wakefield Community School is committed to providing a drug-free environment for its staff and students. To this end, the Wakefield Community School endorses a commitment to insure a work place and educational environment free from the detrimental effects of illicit drugs by the manufacture, possession, distribution or use of controlled substances.

Use of tobacco, alcohol and drugs by minors is prohibited by the laws of the State of Nebraska. Consequently school pupils cannot be permitted to use or be in possession of tobacco, alcohol and drugs on the school grounds or while under school jurisdiction at any or our school activities, away or at home. The football field is part of the school ground during school activities. Violation of this law can result in a suspension from school and activities.

Any student violating the drug-free policy will be disciplined to the fullest extent provided by law.

The Wakefield Community School certifies that it has adopted and implemented a drug prevention program for its students that includes:

1. A K-12 drug education program
2. Documentation that indicates students have been told that use of drugs is illegal and that they are harmful to the human body.
3. Rules that prohibit the use, possession and distribution of illicit drugs.
4. A statement that disciplinary actions will be imposed on students who violate the standards of the drug-free environment.
5. Information about any drug and alcohol counseling and rehabilitation/re entry programs are made available to students.
6. A requirement that parents and students be given a copy of the drug prevention program and that compliance is mandatory.
