Communication is a key for teacher, parents, patrons and students and to keep informed of all activities going on at the school is very important. There are many ways to keep and stay well informed about what is going on at school.

The first is to visit the website and become a member of our “News Update” group. It’s simple and easy to have the most current information added to our website sent directly to your email. To sign up, go to the school’s website at <http://www.wakefieldschool.org> and type your email address in the News Update box located on the left-hand side and clicking the word “go.”

The second is to read the most current newsletter. The newsletter is available by clicking on the box labeled “Newsletter” on the left-hand side of the front page of our website.

If you would like to keep informed on a daily basis of the activities happening at school, the daily announcements are what you need. The announcements are updated throughout the day and can be accessed by clicking on the “Daily Announcements” tab located on the upper right-hand side of the front page of our website. At the very least you will find a list of activities, the lunch menu, and the breakfast menu. You will also be able to scroll from day to day by choosing the date at the bottom of the daily bulletin page.

In addition to the information on the website, I would also like to take the opportunity to let you know about a few projects we have in progress right now. At the March meeting, the board of education reviewed and accepted three bids that will allow asbestos tile to be removed from the kitchen, lunchroom, and stage area. The board also accepted a bid to replace the tile, stove, and oven. All upgrades to the kitchen will take place this summer and be ready for the start of the 2011-2012 school year.

At the April meeting, the school board will be considering access controls for the main door located near the library and main elementary doors. Also for consideration will be an amendment to the 2010-2011 budget. This amendment will not change the tax levy set in September and will allow some flexibility for funding in future years.
