Board of Education Facility Priorities

- Track and Field Facility
- Main Gym
 - Air Movement; Floor; Lights; Paint
- District Transportation
 - Replacement of 15 Passenger Vans
 - Bus Barn Facility
- School Building Safety and Security
- Maintenance Plan for Facilities

Wakefield Community School, in cooperation with family and community, is committed to providing a safe learning environment for each student to attain a quality comprehensive education. The school community is dedicated to prepare all students to be critical thinkers, lifelong learners, and responsible/productive citizens for successful participation in a global society.

The following costs are the preliminary estimates associated with this project.

- A. Estimated costs are \$782,870 – 826,870. This includes:
 - a. Preliminary site grading
 - b. Track (fine grading, drainage system, 8-lane track base and polyurethane top coat and field event layout)
 - c. Fence
 - d. Site concrete, landscaping
 - e. Project costs including architectural and engineering
 - f. 10% contingency

B. Project Timeline

- a. Board approval of track concept/layout at September 2008 meeting
- b. Host public informational meeting (November 2, 2008)
- c. Details of facility planning completed by January 2008
- d. Construction Bids for Project – February 2009
- e. Contract awarded – March 2009
- f. Construction begins March 2009
- g. Completion of Track/field project – Fall 2009

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
